\* – Before Mass on December 2<sup>nd</sup>, briefly refresh the congregation’s memories by rehearsing the response to the Prayer of the Faithful. After each petition the cantor intones “To you we pray,” and everyone else, but not the cantor, responds “Hear us, O Lord.”

\*\* – Each week during the season of Advent, either call forth children before Mass or enlist the help of the ushers in distributing to the members of the congregation the handbells to be rung.

Do not announce or post the number of this song on the hymn board.

Announce the Gathering Hymn as follows: “The Gathering Hymn is “Stay Awake”, during which we may clap or ring bells at the appropriate moments. We begin by echoing the refrain sung by the cantor. Please stand.”

Be sure to have the two-page version titled “Stay Awake (adapted).” Sing the verses mentioned for each week.

\*\*\* - For the Presentation Song on Dec. 9<sup>th</sup>, the cantor should announce the hymn as follows: “The song during the presentation of the gifts is #831 in your hymnal “Canticle of Zechariah” who was the father of John the Baptist #831 - sung to the melody of Amazing Grace”.

To sing the whole text, it will take 6 times through the “Amazing Grace” melody.

\*\*\*\* - On the weekend of Dec. 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>, the Anointing of the Sick will be offered to all those in attendance at all Masses who wish to receive this Sacrament. The anointing will take place following the homily. The following is the list of hymns that will be sung during this time in the Mass and in the order that I believe they should be presented. It is my thought that they should all be done softly so that the music is strictly background and does not detract from the importance and grace of this sacrament. Please have them ready.
