(\*\*) – In place of the Prelude Song, the Music Ministry at all Masses is to introduce the new Mass setting “Mass of Creation”, making a point that some portions of this setting should sound familiar to many since it has been sung in our parish community in the past and then rehearsing both the refrain from the Mass of Creation “Gloria” and the Mystery of Faith “We Proclaim Your Death”, with the music ministers first singing it and having the congregation repeat a few times to follow.
